Easy Steps to Collect:

1. Distribute boxes to local businesses, churches, or a location of your choice. Attach a book collection poster to let people know what you're collecting.
2. Hand out flyers to friends and family, post on social media, make phone calls, let everyone know about the book drive and collect those books!
3. Make a final collection of books and deliver them to United Way of Medina County by Friday, June 7th. Then join us on Friday, June 14th to help clean and sort books to ready for distribution.
4. On Thursday, June 20th books will be delivered to Summer Reinforcement Program. Volunteers are welcome to join us at 10:00 am at Blake Elementary School to distribute books to students!
